NOTE: USE FAT32!!!

## gparted

- delete partitions
- create msdos partition table
- add fat32 partition
- add boot flag

```
#set boot flag via command line:  
sudo parted /dev/sdX set 1 boot on
```

```
sudo mkdir -p /mnt/usb  
sudo mount /dev/sdX1 /mnt/usb  
sudo grub-install --target=i386-pc --boot-directory="/mnt/usb/boot" /dev/sdX
```

```
sudo mkdir -p /mnt/iso  
sudo mount -o loop /tmp/LinuxMint.iso /mnt/iso
```

```
sudo cp -av /mnt/iso/* /mnt/usb/
```
