

Terminal focus

On Linux mint 22.3 the terminal does not get focus when opened via taskbar button due to an issue with underlying mutter.

Workaround as described here: <https://github.com/linuxmint/cinnamon/issues/13382>

```
sudo vi /usr/share/cinnamon/js/ui/windowAttentionHandler.js
```

Search for the initialization block. It looks like this:

```
Mainloop.timeout_add_seconds(4, () => {
  log("Enabling WindowAttentionHandler");
  global.display.connect('window-demands-attention', Lang.bind(this,
this._onWindowDemandsAttention));
  global.display.connect('window-marked-urgent', Lang.bind(this,
this._onWindowDemandsAttention));

  return GLib.SOURCE_REMOVE;
})
```

Add this line inside that block:

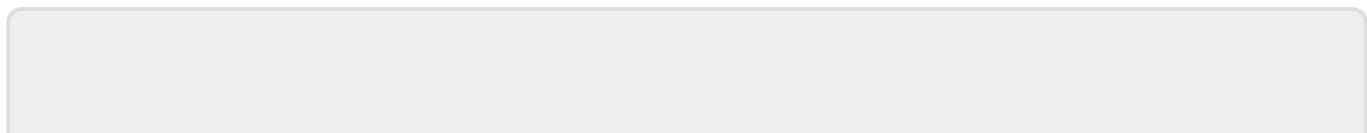
```
global.display.connect('window-created', Lang.bind(this,
this._onWindowDemandsAttention));
```

The result should look like this:

```
Mainloop.timeout_add_seconds(4, () => {
  log("Enabling WindowAttentionHandler");
  global.display.connect('window-demands-attention', Lang.bind(this,
this._onWindowDemandsAttention));
  global.display.connect('window-marked-urgent', Lang.bind(this,
this._onWindowDemandsAttention));
  // START FIX
  global.display.connect('window-created', Lang.bind(this,
this._onWindowDemandsAttention));
  // END FIX

  return GLib.SOURCE_REMOVE;
})
```
